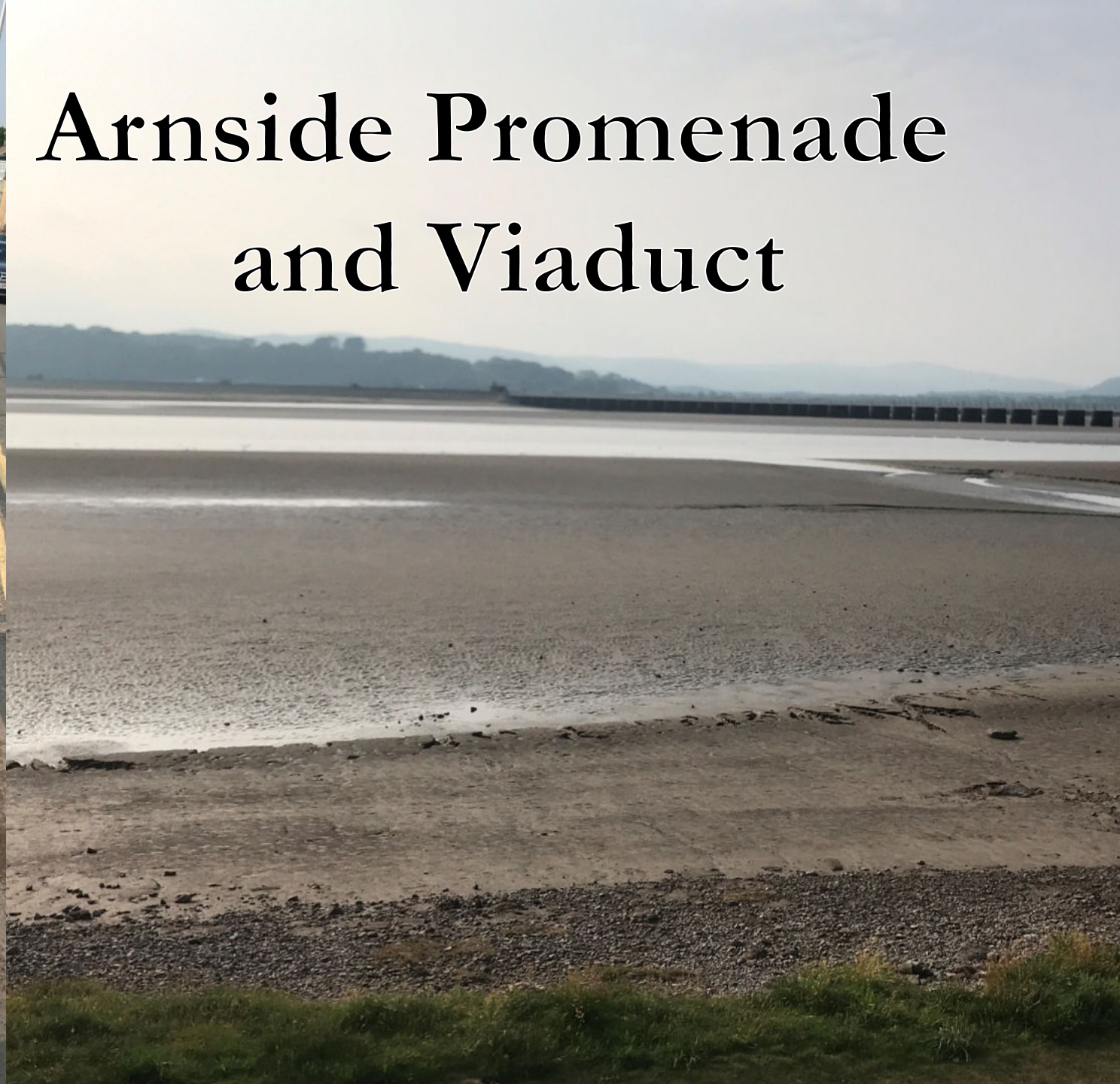

Maidenhair Fern

Adiantum capillus-veneris

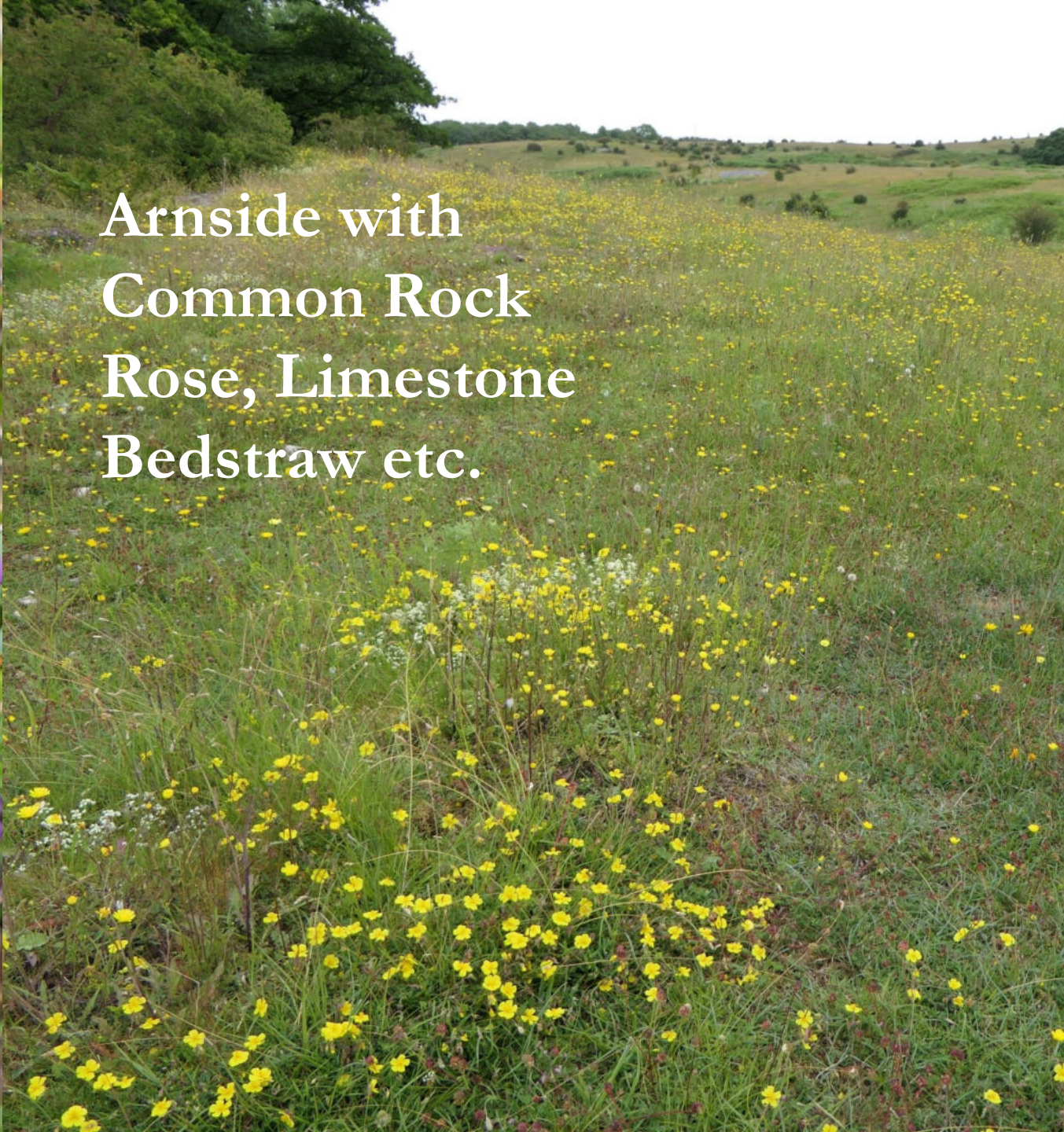

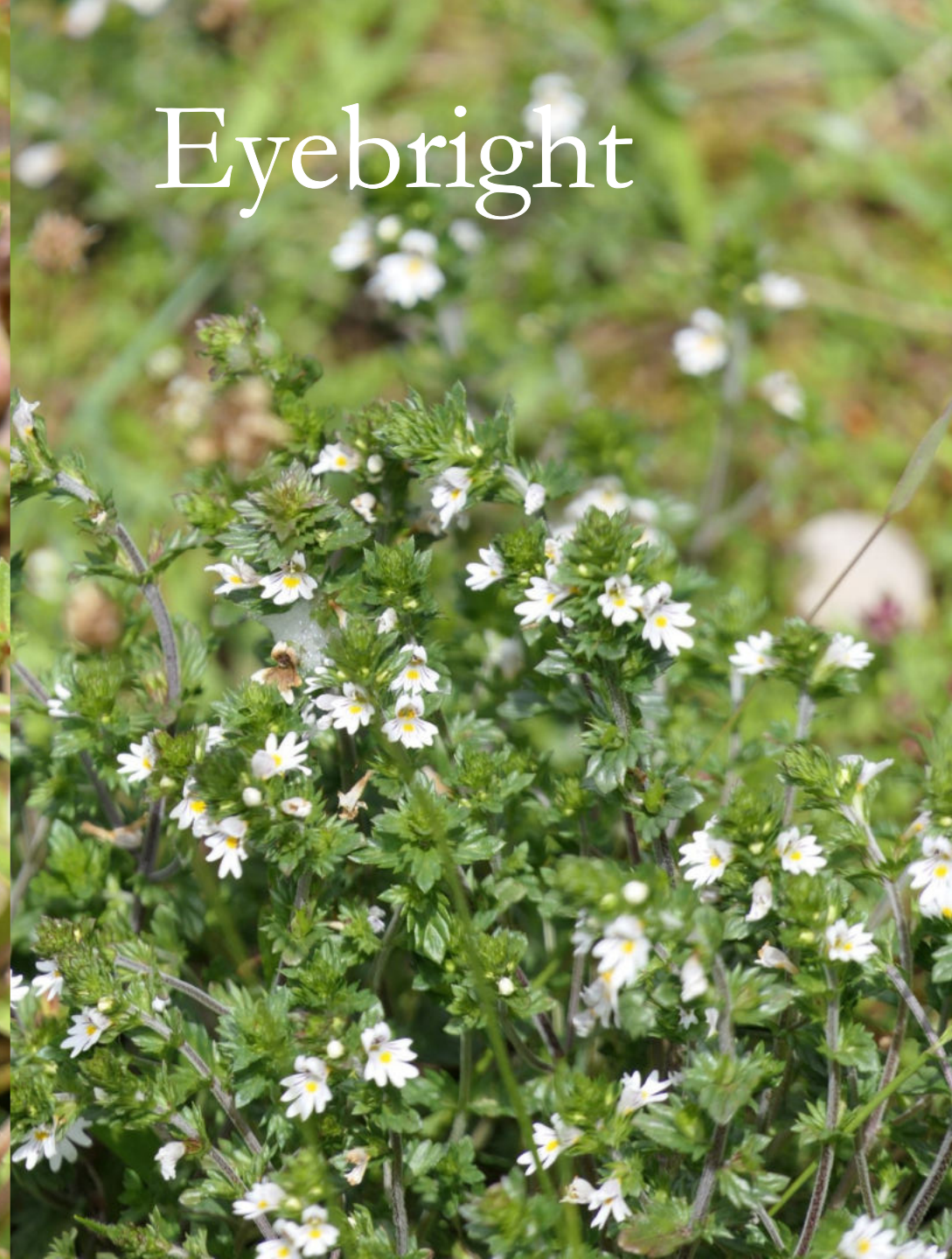
